Question to Think About (and Share):

What would be your two rules that everyone would have to follow? (go around the room and make sure all family members answer the question)

What would be your number one rule? What would be your second rule?

(After everyone has answered let them know) God has two rules He has made more important than any other rules.

Does anyone have any idea what they are?

Let's look at them in Matthew 22:35-40 CEV

35 "One Pharisee, who was an expert on the law of Moses, asked Jesus this question to test him: **36** "Teacher, which command in the law is the most important?"

37 Jesus answered, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.'[d] **38** This is the first and most important command. **39** And the second command is like the first: 'Love your neighbor as you love yourself.'[e] **40** All the law and the writings of the prophets depend on these two commands." **Matthew 22:35 - 40 CEV**

What are some rules that stick out in our house?
