

Parent's Guide to Resuming In-Person Worship for Children

Check-in

- The XK Wellness Policy will be posted & clearly visible.
- Registration required.
- Mobile check-in will be available.
- No self-check-in on-site until further notice.
- Social distancing will be encouraged and facilitated as much as possible.
- Volunteers will be masked at all times.
- Children over the age of 2 should be masked at all times.
- We encourage one parent to drop off and pick up when possible to limit traffic and congestion.
- No parents will be permitted to walk down the hallways. (Exceptions-toddlers with severe separation anxiety, or first-time guests, orientation tours)
- No personal items (bags, toys, or food) will be permitted. (Parents will be called if diaper changes are needed.)
- Hand sanitizer must be used before entering XK doors.
- Lots of big waves, but let's avoid hugs, high-fives, and handshakes!

Toddler & Preschool Experiences

- Limited number of children in our Large Group Experience and in each small group.
 - 18 months - 23 months (1:3)
 - 2 years (1:6)
 - Preschool (3's & 4's) (1:10)
- Small groups will be 1:10 as much as possible.
- If pacifiers are used, they should be on a clip and attached to the child.
- Gowned volunteers in the event a child needs to be picked up.
- Toys will not be shared whenever possible.
- Separate toys for each service as much as possible.
- Non-porous toys only will be provided.
- No snacks will be provided or allowed in the space at this time.
- Sanitization of all counters, toys, and hard surfaces will happen before, during, and after services.

Elementary & Preteen Experiences

- Limited number of children in our Large Group Experience and in each small group.
 - School-age (K-6) (1:15)
- Small groups will be 1:10 as much as possible.
- No food or drinks in any room
- Social distancing will be encouraged as much as possible
- Sanitization of all counters, toys, and hard surfaces will happen before, during, and after services.

Check-out

- Parents will not be permitted to walk down the halls.
- Children will be called using the walkie-talkies and a volunteer will walk them to the front.
- Check-out will take place outside the XK experience areas (same as check-in) until further notice.
- Parents must have the validation tag provided at check-in or will need to go back to check-in, provide ID, and have the tag reprinted.
- Kids will receive hand sanitizer as they exit.
